A physical survey of Allen Creek (the creek running through Scott Lake) will be conducted after August 14th and before September 15th. There will be activity in the creek and along the banks. Many of you are familiar with the Allen Creek Maintenance Project. Property flooding has been considerably reduced and our roadways have not been covered with water during the fall and winter months. Removing years of storm debris and continued creek maintenance have improved living conditions in and around our neighborhood.
