# Fall is around the Corner-Urgent-Reminder

**the ditch** in front of the house-free of weeds-not smashed-not free flowing? If any of these apply, it's time to get your culvert cleaned and ready for rainy days. Having culverts and ditches that hold the rainwater and direct it to the various areas, allows for less flooding in your neighborhood.

### **Water Committee**

On August 31st Inland Potable cleaned and inspected both reservoirs on Champion Hill. We received the video and are awaiting the written assessment report.

Electrical repairs were done on the Well #6 electrical as it kept tripping off. It now is coming on and staying on as needed.

KCL is planning on installing additional shut off valves in the water distribution system in early October. The work will require water shut offs in the system for one day and then a couple of days of boil water notice will happen until water quality testing is completed. The installation of additional valves allows fewer people to have their water turned off during repairs or improvements once all the isolation valves are installed. There will be several more valve installations after this, but we are getting closer to having the planned ones completed. When a specific date is known, the community will be notified.

# **Governance Committee**

Bylaws Updated: diligent work is being done on updating our Bylaws They were written in 1962 and haven't been updated since. While we don't know the exact date we will finish, we felt it's important to get awareness out to the community of the coming changes and further, the community ratifying them with a vote. The B.O.T.'s plan is to have multiple town hall meetings to discuss the details of the bylaw changes, answer questions and hear concerns. We will post the dates of these town hall meetings soon, but the idea is that we'll have multiple to accommodate your busy schedules. These will be held in person and over zoom.
