Another valve cluster was installed at Scotlac and Driver. Only a few more and we will have installed all of the isolation valves planned for our water system. Our water system was built with no isolation valves, requiring the shut off of the entire water system any time work was done on the system. This is allowing for smaller areas of water shut off depending on the work needing to

be done. The Water Committee is continuing to work on different issues associated with the water system, including updating our Water rules and policies, improving our record keeping, working with the Office and Treasurer on our financial practices, Etc.
