This is where the "If You See Something, Say Something" principle comes into play. By staying alert and notifying the proper authorities when something feels off, we can deter crime and maintain the security of our homes.

#### What Should You Look For?

- People or vehicles acting suspiciously, such as unknown individuals walking through yards or parked cars without an apparent reason for being there.
- Strange disturbances in your area include missing property, car rummaging, or broken items/property.
- All broken or damaged community property may be an indication of vandalism.

# What to Do When You See Something Suspicious:

- **Stay Safe:** Do not approach anyone or intervene directly. Your safety is the priority.
- **Report It:** Contact the SLMC office via phone or email, or the local authorities. Provide as many details as possible (e.g., time, location, description of people or vehicles involved).
- **Stay Anonymous:** If you prefer, you can always remain anonymous when reporting.

Remember, when we all contribute to the safety of our community, we create an environment where everyone can feel secure and enjoy their homes.
